Offline Hackathon in the Carpathians

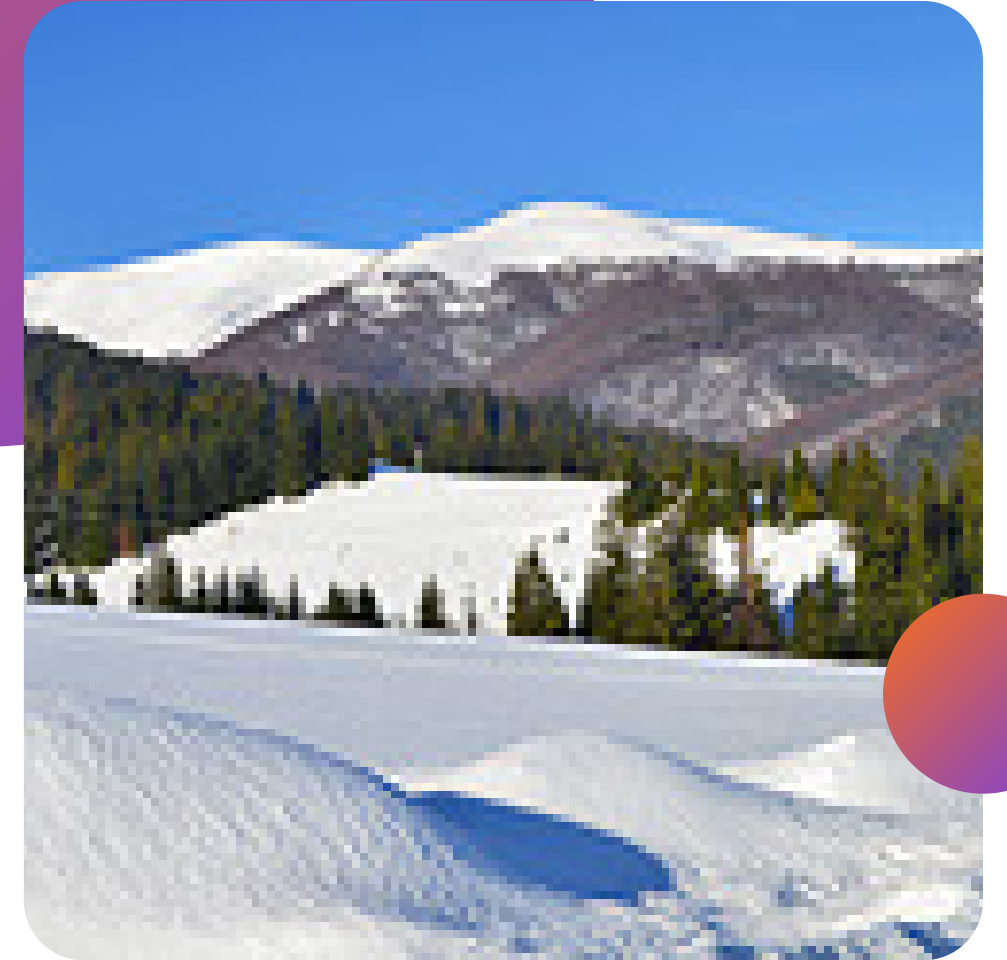
Conducting an offline hackathon "Development of solutions to ensure advantages in cyber warfare", which will be held in the Carpathians

Hackathon venue

Ski complex "Magura"

The "Magura" ski complex is located in the village of Pylypets at an altitude of 1,000 m above sea level on the slopes of Mount Hymba in the midst of a coniferous forest.

01

The "Magura" complex includes four wooden cottages. On the territory of the complex there is a sauna, a two-story restaurant, a small hut, and a ski equipment rental point. The restaurant is equipped with a conference hall

There are also two own bugle lifts for professionals and beginners. At a distance of 700 m from the complex there is a chair lift to Mount Gemba (1680 m). Directly near the complex are laid ski tracks of various levels of difficulty. The complex has its own shuttle, tourists are delivered to the hotel
